2010 NATIONAL STUDENT RESEARCH AWARD**

The American College of Sports Medicine is pleased to announce the National Student Research Award. This award will be presented to the student with the most outstanding research project of the year. An important consideration for the award is the extent of the student's participation in the project.

Students eligible for this award must meet the following requirements:

1. At the time of application, the applicant must be presently enrolled/accepted into a graduate or professional program in the areas of clinical or basic exercise science or sports medicine at an accredited university OR have graduated from such a program within one year prior to this award's application date. In the latter case, only work accomplished before graduation should be submitted.
2. Principal author of the abstract submitted and accepted for presentation at the upcoming ACSM Annual Meeting. The abstract must be original research in exercise science and should include the following: 1) statement of the problem, 2) methods and 3) results and conclusions. The work reported in the abstract must have been completed for academic credit toward completion of a graduate degree (e.g., M.S., Ph.D., M.D., etc.)
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from the student's project director using the attached Letter of Recommendation from Project Director Form.
4. Must be a member of the American College of Sports Medicine or one of its Regional Chapters at the time of application and at the time the award is presented.

Application Materials Include:

1. Completed ACSM National Student Research Award application form (page 1).
2. Copy of abstract submitted to Annual Meeting (page 2).
3. Biographical Sketch (pages 3-6).
4. Completed letter of recommendation (pages 7-8).
5. Expanded abstract (5 page maximum; this includes text, graphs, charts, references, etc.). The short report must be double spaced with no more than 15 characters per horizontal inch. Submit as an appended or separate Adobe Acrobat (PDF) file.

Incorrectly prepared extended abstracts will be returned without review.

DEADLINE FOR COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET IS: MARCH 5, 2010.






