

**2021 Gail E. Butterfield, Ph.D., R.D., FACSM
Nutrition Registration Award**

BACKGROUND:

Gail E. Butterfield, Ph.D., R.D., FACSM, passed on December 27, 1999, and was a member of ACSM for 21 years. Dr. Butterfield served on the ACSM Board of Trustees from 1994-1996 and was one of the five founding members of the ACSM Nutrition Special Interest Group. In addition, Dr. Butterfield served on five separate committees during her ACSM membership: Pronouncements; Programs; Awards and Tributes; Liaisons Ad hoc; and Public Information. During her ACSM membership, Dr. Butterfield held faculty and research positions at the University of California – Berkeley, Stanford University, and the Palo Alto Veterans Administration Hospital.



AWARD:

In 2021, the American College of Sports Medicine Foundation will be offering two (2) Registration Awards through the *Gail E. Butterfield Nutrition Travel Award Fund*. The purpose of the awards is to advance education for two (2) Ph.D. students (one from the U.S. and one international student) by providing complimentary registration to present their scholarly work at ACSM's 68th Annual Meeting June 1-5, 2021.

2021 Gail E. Butterfield Nutrition Registration Award

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a Ph.D. student in good standing conducting research in **human subjects** focusing on one or more of the following five areas: protein metabolism, altitude and nutrition, energy balance, nutrition and exercise interventions to improve metabolic health, or nutrition and the female athlete.
2. Must be an ACSM member. If not currently a member, please visit www.acsm.org, and click on the “Membership” tab for information, benefits and instructions.
3. Must be presenting a research project at the upcoming ACSM Annual Meeting. *As final Annual Meeting abstract selections may not be released by the application deadline date, interested candidates are encouraged to apply with their submitted abstract, and verification of acceptance will be made during the application review process.*
4. Must have a faculty sponsor, who must sign the application indicating that the student is a current student in good standing, the student is responsible for the research project being presented and verify the college/university has limited research funds for the student to present his or her scholarly work.
5. **Applications must be received by the ACSM office by 5:00 p.m. EST on April 5, 2021.**
6. Applications must be directed to foundation@acsm.org. Please type “2021 Gail E. Butterfield Nutrition Registration Award” in the e-mail subject line. **Along with a completed application, send a copy of your research abstract in pdf format.**
7. Announcement of the two (2) award recipients will be made on May 3, 2021.
8. Previous recipients of the Gail E. Butterfield Nutrition Travel Award will not be eligible for selection in 2021.
