

American College of Sports Medicine 2021 Visiting Scholar Award

The Visiting Scholar Award is given to investigators who need further experience as independent researchers. The purpose of the award is to provide financial support for an investigator to visit a clinic or laboratory of his/her choice to learn new and current techniques in exercise and sports medicine. Travel, financial support and laboratory supplies will be provided to the recipient for a period of up to six months. A maximum of \$5,000 will be awarded.

Requirements

1. The applicant must be a current member of ACSM for at least two consecutive years including student status membership.
2. The applicant must hold a doctoral degree (Ph.D., M.D., or equivalent).
3. The visit must occur after official award notification.
4. Only one laboratory may be visited.
5. A written report of activities must be submitted within three months after completion of the visit.
6. Applicant must submit pages 2-11 completed and combined into a single Adobe Acrobat (PDF) file.
7. Applicant must submit approval letter from both present and host facility that should briefly address the plan for the applicant's training during the visit. Approval letters from both present and host facilities should be submitted as appended or separate Adobe Acrobat (PDF) files.



2021 Visiting Scholar Award Category Descriptions

Research Background: Judgment based upon evidence of successful and high-quality training, consistent scholarship in research achievement as indicated by number and quality of publications and research funding.

Impact of the Proposed Visit: Potential impact of the proposed visit as indicated by planned research collaborations, publications, and grant applications.

Rationale for Lab Selection: Judgement based upon description and rationale for selection of laboratory to be visited and relevance to applicant's current research.

Rationale for Funds: Description of importance of the visiting scholar fund for the proposed visit, specifically, rationale of additional funds if the applicant has other current grant support.

Support from Present and Host Facilities: Judgment based upon supportive approval letters from the present and host facilities, specifically, an appropriate support letter with a training plan during the proposed visit from the host facility.

Written Report: After funding is received, the awardee must contact Jessi Warner at jwarner@acsm.org for an approval if changes are needed on planned activities that use the funds. A written report of activities with final budget must be submitted within three months after completion of the visit. Awardees who fail to do so could be reported to the ACSM Ethics and Professional Conduct Committee.
