Introduction

The Northland Regional Chapter of the American College of Sports Medicine (NLACSM) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit professional organization consisting of a diverse group of professionals and students dedicated to the advancement of sports medicine and exercise science.

The chapter seeks to communicate scientific information, provide a forum for research, foster professional peer interaction, and support career growth. NLACSM adheres to the mission of the American College of Sports Medicine (ACSM) on a regional level. While our members are primarily from Minnesota, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota, we welcome members from neighboring states and Canadian provinces as well.

The primary means by which the Chapter achieves this mission is the annual conference. In previous years, over 200 members, including physicians, scientists, clinicians, educators, health professionals, graduate, and undergraduate students have attended this conference. The conference is designed to provide NLACSM members and affiliated professionals with the most current, up-to-date, and emerging information on sports medicine and exercise science. The conference offers a variety of sessions which includes regional presenters along with nationally recognized experts in the areas of sports medicine and exercise science presenting their latest research findings.
