


ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN REHABILITATION SCIENCE

The Division of Kinesiology and Health, in the College of Health Sciences, is seeking a tenure-track assistant professor specialized in rehabilitation science (9-month full time) beginning in august 2024. The candidate is expected to <u>develop</u> an active and independent research program; <u>pursue and secure</u> funding; <u>teach</u> at the undergraduate and graduate levels; <u>advise and mentor</u> undergraduate and graduate students; <u>serve</u> the division, college, university, community, and state, with expertise in rehabilitation science or related areas.



- Earned doctorate by August 2024 in Rehabilitation Science, Movement Science, Kinesiology, Exercise Science, Physical Therapy, Athletic Training, Biomedical Science, or a closely related field Commensurate with career stage, evidence of the following:
- Experience teaching in university-level courses
- Established and/or developing line/s of research that will result in publications in peer-reviewed journals and securing grant funding

Preferred Qualifications [desired qualifications]

- Postdoctoral training and/or post-graduate clinical experience in fields related to rehabilitation science
- Established record of peer-reviewed publications in reputable journals
- Working effectively as a member of collaborative and/or interdisciplinary teams
- Research agenda that can leverage the University and College initiatives and existing faculty expertise within the division
- Working with diverse populations in promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Strong oral and written communication in academic settings
- Specific interest in the place and/or position.

- Teaching effectiveness in undergraduate and/or graduate courses related to rehabilitation science that complements or extends existing curriculum within the division

- Advising and mentoring undergraduate and/or graduate students

- Statement of contributions to advancing Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
- 3 publications or other scholarly writing samples that are representative of the breadth and depth of scholarly work

Electronic submission of application materials is required! ABD will be considered if doctoral degree can be completed by the job starting date. Applications will be accepted until the position is filled. To ensure full consideration, complete applications must be received by **11:59 pm (MT) on December 1, 2023**.
