

TACSM BODY COMPOSITION RESEARCH SCHOLARSHIP

Overview

The TACSM Board of Directors has approved an award(s) (maximum of \$1000) to be given to a deserving TACSM student member who has been active and shown research interests in body composition research. The intent of the award is to provide money for a student(s) to be used in the pursuit of his/her academic goals.

Submission Deadline: December 1, 2021

Eligibility Requirements

1. Student member of TACSM prior to August 1, 2021.
2. Enrolled in an institution in Texas during the current academic year.
3. Declared major in kinesiology, exercise science, or a related field with 3.5 GPA for last 60 hours of completed coursework.
4. Evidence of involvement in research in the area of body composition.
5. Plans to continue in this line of research in future academic endeavors.

Application Requirements

1. Personal Statement up to 1000 words describing academic and professional goals, achievements, and activities that includes a description of their body composition research, as well as future plans/goals in body composition research.
2. Resume/Curriculum Vita.
3. Official Transcript.
4. Two letters of recommendation with at least one from a TACSM member.

Application Requirements

This scholarship has a maximum value of \$1,000. The review committee has the option to select up to 2 recipients of the award, and if two winners are identified, the award value will be \$500 per recipient. The funds associated with this scholarship will go directly to the student winner.

Application Submission

Your major professor must submit your application electronically as a single, compiled file (PLEASE do not submit multiple files!) to the [TACSM Associate Executive Director](#).
